Below are some important highlights to note from the above referenced links:

ALL non-essential CUNY business travel should continue to be postponed until further notice.

- Waivers are required for any essential CUNY business travel regardless of the funding source.
 - Waivers should be submitted and approved prior to making any financial commitments.
 - Waivers must be attached to the Travel Expense Report in CUNYfirst.
- NO LONGER APPLICABLE ___ Personal Travel (NOT CUNY business related): may be subject to mandatory or
 precautionary order of quarantine, CUNY employees shall not receive paid sick leave or any paid benefits
 provided by Chapter 25 of the NYS Laws of 2020 to fulfill the quarantine period.
- The University has announced that the CUNY Athletic Conference will resume sports in Fall 2021. Since trips for athletic competitions are reviewed through a separate process, team members and staff are exempt from the individual travel waiver requirement.
